



WALK WISE HAWAII Reminds Pedestrians to:

- ❖ Always cross at a crosswalk or at the corner.
- ❖ Look for oncoming vehicles before stepping down from sidewalk.
- ❖ When possible, establish eye contact with drivers and continue looking left-right-left while crossing.
- ❖ Remember that oncoming vehicles may approach more quickly than anticipated.
- ❖ Make sure you are seen: wear bright or light colored clothing and use retro-reflective materials when dark outside.

WALK WISE HAWAII Reminds Drivers to:

- ❖ Stop for pedestrians.
- ❖ Stay focused and alert for sudden pedestrian movement when driving.
- ❖ Watch for pedestrians crossing multi-lane streets; they may be hidden by a stopped car until in front of you.
- ❖ Be alert when it is dark outside: most pedestrian fatalities occur at dawn and dusk.
